

PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

Veronét Vineyards & Winery (VVW) considers portraiture by a professional photographer to be professional photography, even if income is not derived. This includes, but is not limited to engagement, bridal, wedding, senior pictures, prom pictures, birthday, and family photography sessions conducted by a professional photographer.

Professional photography requires approval, must be scheduled at least 2 weeks in advance, and comply with our photography policy. A photography fee applies to all professional photography as well as any bridal, engagement, family portraits, etc. taken by professional **or amateur** photographers. Photography Policies

The policies below must be followed for all photography sessions using Veronét Vineyards & Winery as a backdrop. Violation of any policy is grounds for immediate ejection from the estate.

1. Professional photography sessions must be scheduled at least 2 weeks in advance.
2. Photography is not permitted during open hours while guests are on the property.
3. Access is limited to a maximum of 12 guests, including photography team.
4. Photography is not permitted on Mondays or during open business hours of 12pm - 6pm, Friday - Sunday.
5. This agreement covers access for outdoor photography; indoor areas may not be used without prior permission.
6. Lighting equipment which requires cords and external power sources or outside props cannot be used without prior permission.
7. Glitter, confetti, open flames, and loose balloons (not attached to weights), are not permitted on the estate at any time.
8. Do not go in the vineyard without prior permission; due to the nature of commercial grape growing, access inside the vines is restricted and must be cleared in advance with the VVW team.
9. No climbing trees and vineyard trellis wires or posts.
10. Do not move, alter, or draw on any structures/property.

11. Do not touch or move plant life.
12. No trampling, picking, or collecting flowers, leaves or grapes.
13. Do not disturb or feed the wildlife.
14. Absolutely NO SMOKING on the property.
15. Vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas.
16. Any and all trash created by you must be removed from the property.
17. Flow of visitors along driveways and pathways must not be blocked at any time.
18. No changing areas are provided. A public restroom is available in the winery.
19. VVW assumes no responsibility for loss, theft, or damage to equipment. Take valuables with you when you park your car.
20. All photographers and clients must check-in and check-out with the manager on duty at the beginning and end of their session.

Commercial Photography

Stock and commercial photography requires advanced, separate, arrangements. Projects involving commercial or stock photography (such as photos taken for publications, websites, retail use, retail social media, catalog shoots, commercials, professional videos, and the like) should contact info@veronetwine.com to review commercial use policies and locations agreements.

Indemnification

Photographer shall be responsible for and does hereby relieve, release, and indemnify Veronét Vineyards & Winery, including its members, staff, volunteers, owners and guests, for all costs, damages, liabilities, and expenses (including attorney fees) by reason of any injury or damage to any person or property upon the premises occupied and used by the Photographer where such injury or damage was caused by or as a result of the acts or failure to act of the Photographer, agents, workers, or employees. Veronét Vineyards & Winery shall not be liable or responsible to the Photographer, the Photographer’s clients or to anyone else by reason of theft, disappearance, or damage sustained by the Photographer or others in connection with the use or storage of items at Veronét Vineyards & Winery. The signing of the Photography Policy does not stipulate exclusive use of Veronét Vineyards & Winery. Veronét Vineyards & Winery reserves the right to refuse admittance for photography and/or change its Photography Policy without advance notice.
