



Policies & Guidelines for Your Visit

We are excited to welcome you back to Veronét Vineyards & Winery. The safety of our guests, team & community is our highest priority. We've pulled together these guidelines to ensure a safe and secure environment for everyone on the property.

Hours:

Outdoor seating only is available by reservation only on Saturdays from 12pm – 6pm and Sundays from 12pm – 6pm, and reservations can be made via our website on the "Visit" page. Our indoor tasting room and private tasting room are not available during this time. Bathrooms will be accessible for our guests.

Seating & Service:

We will be offering seating on our patios as well as picnic table seating on our lawn areas. All seating will either be under our louvered pergola or have an umbrella for shade. At this time, we will not be able to accommodate any group larger than 8 people due to health & safety guidance.

Upon arrival, please check-in at the gate, and a tasting associate will await you outside the main entrance of the winery to guide you to your designated seating area. Please do not enter the building upon arrival.

Guests will be able to order at two outdoor locations; one on our patio and one on our lawn. You will be able to order wine by the bottle, wine by the glass, and wine flights. **No wine tastings or food is being offered at this time.**

We ask that all orders are placed before the final 30 minutes of your reservation duration to ensure ample time to enjoy before the close of service.

Food:

At this time, we are not offering any food items for sale from the winery. You are welcome to bring your own food to enjoy on the property, or to visit the food truck vendor who will be onsite from 12:30pm – 5:30pm. If you do bring your own food we ask that you please dispose of all utensils, napkins, and packaging in a designated trash receptacle in order to help us maintain a sanitary environment for all guests.



Inclement Weather:

In case of inclement weather, we are not able to change a reservation to provide covered or indoor seating. Please check the weather and plan ahead; if it is too windy, hot, or it rains during your visit, you can choose to wait it out in your vehicle and we will hold your table for the duration of your reservation.

Safety & Hygiene:

For the safety of all guests on the property and our team, Veronét staff will be wearing facial coverings and gloves at all times.

In accordance with NCDHHS guidelines, all guests must adhere to distancing guidelines of 6 feet between groups and individuals from separate parties, and are required to wear a face covering any time social distancing is not possible or when engaging with individuals who do not reside in the same household.
