



Policies & Guidelines for Your Visit

We are excited to welcome you back to Veronét Vineyards & Winery. The safety of our guests, team & community is our highest priority. We've pulled together these guidelines to ensure a safe and secure environment for everyone on the property.

Hours:

We are open Saturdays & Sundays from 12pm – 6pm. Our indoor tasting room is open with limited seating to comply with NCDHHS capacity and social distancing guidelines, our outdoor seating is socially distant to ensure health & safety, and guests are permitted to bring their own chairs and blankets to enjoy our lawn area as long as they remain socially distant from other groups.

Seating & Service:

Seating is available first come, first serve at both our indoor and outdoor seating areas. Our outdoor seating areas are open rain or shine, and do not provide any significant protection from wind or rain. Please come dressed for the weather as due to limited indoor capacity, we cannot guarantee indoor seating availability. Guests are permitted to bring their own chairs and blankets to enjoy our lawn area; please be sure to remain socially distant from other groups.

All wine is served bar service style at one of our two indoor bars. You will be able to order wine by the bottle, wine by the glass, and wine flights. **No wine tastings or food is being offered at this time.**

Final pour is at 5:30pm; after 5:30pm only closed bottles are available for take-home.

Food:

At this time, we are not offering any food items for sale from the winery. You are welcome to bring your own food to enjoy on the property, or to visit the food truck vendor who will be on-site from 12:30pm – 5:30pm. If you do bring your own food we ask that you please dispose of all utensils, napkins, and packaging in a designated trash receptacle in order to help us maintain a sanitary environment for all guests. No outside alcohol is allowed on the property at any time. No outside food, except for food from our food truck partners, is permitted inside the winery; all outside food must be enjoyed at our outdoor seating areas.



Inclement Weather:

In case of inclement weather, we cannot guarantee indoor seating. Please check the weather and plan ahead.

Safety & Hygiene:

For the safety of all guests on the property and our team, Veronét staff will be wearing facial coverings and gloves at all times.

In accordance with NCDHHS guidelines, masks must be worn indoors at all times when not seated. All guests must adhere to distancing guidelines of 6 feet between groups and individuals from separate parties. Outdoors, guests are required to wear a face covering any time social distancing is not possible or when engaging with individuals who do not reside in the same household.
